Introducing Compact Router Firmware File SV0877-21 Build 2082

This release documents applications and firmware that support the Nvision Compact Router Series of frames.

The version assigned to this release is SV0877-21 and its build number is 2082

This release addresses the following issues:

Fixes

NVCR-513: Fixed bad video output observed on CQX 3GIG and CQX HD frames when SD video input is from a Tektronix SPG8000A .

Known Issues

NVCR-515: CRSC reports that CQX patch release (App Code SV0987-10A) update failed

The CRSC application displays an error when updating with the CQX firmware file SV0877-21 and the CRSC application. CRSC will display a dialog which indicates the update failed since it detects a part number mismatch. *The CQX firmware actually did update and will function properly*, but the version reported is not correct. Code reported version 16.0.0.0, but it should be version 10.0.0.0.

Workaround

 Using CRSC application, update the firmware as specified in the CRSC User's Guide. When the dialog window displays the error: (Error) Expecting version "SV0987-10A0 Version 10.0.0.0" but have version "SV0987-10A0 Version 16.0.0.0", close the dialog and ignore the error.



 To make sure the update was successful; select the "Firmware Updates" option under the "Administrative Tools" left side bar of the CRSC application. Select the CQX router and note the part number should display SV0987-10A v16.0.0.0 as shown in the image below.
